Keys to Growth Scholarship Program

Keys to Growth Inc. (KTG) is a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit dedicated to providing musical instrument training that nurtures the personal, academic and artistic development of Greater Cleveland's at risk citizens ages 4 to 94. Some of the many benefits of musical instrument training includes: better grades, problem solving skills and memory; lower crime, school dropouts and anxiety; and the development of critical life skills including discipline, focus, creativity, dexterity, socialization, and social capital, while unlocking musical gifts.

Lessons will be taught in small groups of five students starting, September at the above address. Younger students are to have a parent (or other adult) take part in each lesson. One group is scheduled for each of the five age ranges.

Am I Eligible?

The family income guidelines used as an initial eligibility criteria, are based on the HHS Poverty Guidelines.

KTG will grant Scholarships to the extent that funds are available. KTG reserves the right to refuse assistance to any applicant. Scholarships may be granted for single 10 week terms or for an entire music year (30weeks) of training. Assistance will be granted on the basis of need, the ability of recipient to attend scheduled classes, and to abide by KTG's behavioral protocol. Student motivation and musical potential may also be considered.
